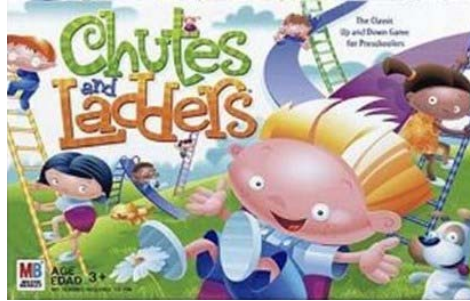


# Environmental Board Games



**Assignment:** You are the board game manufacturer, and you have been assigned the task of creating a board game that will help students review everything they learned in Environmental Science in a fun, interesting and challenging way.

**Requirements:** Brainstorming, Preliminary Phase

1. What makes a good board game?
  - a. Bring in a board game of your choice that you think is fun or you enjoy/enjoyed in the past. \_\_\_\_\_/5
  - b. Over the course of the next 2 or 3 periods, we will play each game for a period of time and analyze aspects of the game you like or enjoy. You will turn in a game review including 10 aspects you would like to potentially include in your environmental game (from experiences playing the games in class, personal experience, and your own creativity). \_\_\_\_\_/10
2. Creation of the board game
  - a. 2 periods brainstorming with a partner what you want to include in your game \_\_\_\_\_/10
  - b. Research in class trivia to be used in your board game \_\_\_\_\_/10
  - c. Collection of photos to be included in some aspect of your game \_\_\_\_\_/10
3. Submission of a general framework for your game \_\_\_\_\_/5
  - a. How your game will work
  - b. How a winner will be determined
  - c. Which game yours will mimic
  - d. How will trivia be included in your game
